1. Present application has been filed under Section 151 CPC for preponing the application bearing CM-3052-CII-2023 in CR-2636-2022.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner as well as learned counsel for the non-applicant/respondent have jointly submitted that the main petition itself, which is listed for hearing on 02.12.2024, be preponed to today.
3. In view of the above, the present application is allowed and the main petition is preponed from 02.12.2024 to today.

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1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the impugned order has been passed by the Family Court, thus, an appeal under Section 19 of the Family Courts Act would be maintainable and

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prays that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to file an appeal, in accordance with law. It is further submitted that the present petitioner had inadvertently filed a wrong affidavit with respect to assets/income/expenditure and he now wishes to place on record an affidavit, which duly reflects his assets/income/expenditure and the said affidavit (Annexure P-8) be read instead of the earlier affidavit (Annexure P-8).

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent has submitted that the respondent will be able to show that the earlier affidavit filed was the correct affidavit, which discloses the entire assets/income/expenditure, and the present affidavit is not correct.
3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty to the applicant-petitioner to file an appeal, in accordance with law.
4. All issues including the issue as to which affidavit reflects the correct assets/income/expenditure of the present petitioner are kept open.
5. Pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of in view of the above.
