1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents official respondents to take legal action against respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel would contend that the petitioner was more meritorious however, respondent No.4 has been appointed. In this regard, a representation dated 08.04.2024 (Annexure P-9), has been submitted by her, which has yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if her representation is directed to be decided in a time bound manner.
