1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been invoked seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass and mentally torture the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.5 by calling them to the office of respondent No.3.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkota to decide the representation dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

3. Notice to the official respondents only, at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab, appearing on advance notice, accepts the same on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab.

5. Without advertng to the facts of the case, the present petition is disposed off, with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their

representation dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) and to decide the same within a period of four weeks from today, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order. The order so passed shall be communicated to the petitioners within one week thereafter.
