1. Present revision petition has been preferred for setting aside the quantum of sentence part of judgment dated 24.04.2012 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Fatehgarh Sahib on the petitioner’s complaint bearing No.111-RT of 2003 dated 07.06.2003 under Sections 406, 498-A, 34 IPC, whereby learned trial Court held the private respondents guilty, however, extended the benefit of probation to respondent Nos.1 and 2 instead of sentencing them to rigorous imprisonment as awarded to respondent No.3.
2. Despite, the case having been called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that neither the petitioner nor her counsel is interested in pursuing the present petition.
3. Under these circumstances, having left with no other option, the present petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution accordingly.
