SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The learned counsel for the petitioners seeks, and, is granted permission to withdraw the present petition, but with liberty to assail Annexure P-6, through an appeal thereagainst being instituted before the Appellate Authority concerned. The said appeal be instituted within a period of two weeks from today, and thereupto, the parties are directed to maintain *status quo*, as it exists today, in respect of the subject lands.

2. On the institution of the said statutory appeal before the Appellate Authority concerned, the present petitioners shall move an application therebefore seeking the staying of the operation Annexure P-3, and, on the said application, lawful orders shall be passed. Moreover, the said statutory appeal is directed to be decided within a period of four months from its preferment, but only after hearing all affected persons concerned.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
