1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ, order or direction restraining the respondents to continue with departmental inquiry by order No. 17128-34, dated 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-3) during the pendency of the judicial criminal trial in case FIR No. 211 dated 13.06.2019 registered under Sections 376 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 3(1) (w) (xii) and 3 (2) (v) S.C/S.T. Act, 1989 and Section 66 E of the IT Act, 2000 at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal.
2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, all the witnesses in the departmental proceedings have already been examined and the Enquiry Officers have also submitted their enquiry report and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.
4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
