Learned State counsel has filed the reply dated 13.07.2023 by way of an affidavit of Narender Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bawal, District Rewari on behalf of respondent No.1-State, which is taken on record.

The instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, in view

of the ratio laid down by this court in *CRM-M-25963-2023* titled as ‘Suresh Kumar and another Vs. The State of Haryana and another’ 2023 (2) *Law Herald 1498*, the personal appearance of the petitioner before the learned trial Court is ordered to be exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) petitioner shall be represented through his counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of his counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required; and
- vi) any other condition, which the trial Court may impose.
