Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to uphold the auction held on 14.06.2019, in which the petitioner was a successful bidder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that so far as the grievance espoused in the present petition is concerned to the said extent, the present petition has become infructuous. He, however, submits that the petitioner may be permitted to participate in other fresh bidding/auction process initiated by the respondents for allotment of the college ground.

Learned counsel for the respective respondents have no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

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The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, with a direction to the respondents that in the event of the college ground being put to re-auction/re-allotment by way of bidding/auction process, the petitioner shall be entitled to participate in the said process.
