By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.15 dated 04.09.2023 under Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station State Operation Cell, SAS Nagar, District Intelligence Wing (CID).

2. As per prosecution allegations, on 04.09.2023, on the basis of secret information co-accused Jagmohan Singh @ Gabbar and Manjit Singh were apprehended as information was to the effect that they along with accomplices used to bring weapons from M.P. & Gujarat for supplying the same in Punjab. On their apprehension, one pistol each were recovered from both of them. During investigation, it emerged that Inderjit Singh and Gursewak Singh @ Sewak (petitioner) are the king pin of the racket. Petitioner was arrested on 11.09.2023 and from his possession a pistol of .32 bore and three live cartridges were recovered.

3. Learned counsel contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that co-accused Jagmohan Singh Gill @ Jagmohan Singh @ Gabbar has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 02.02.2024 passed in CRM-M-



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8. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, particularly on the basis of parity, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
