1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking direction to respondent No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 who are extending threats to cause physical harm to the petitioners who performed marriage on 17.11.2023 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7 and since then the private respondents are giving threats and in this regard representation Annexure P-4 dated 08.05.2024 is already given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action in this regard.

2. In compliance of the previous order, the petitioners have appeared in person and petitioner No.2 submits that even now, respondents No.4 to 7 are against her marriage with petitioner No.1 and both the petitioners are apprehending threats from the side of respondents No.4 to 7.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sidakmeet Sandhu, Addl. P.P. UT Chandigarh, accepts

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notice on behalf of State of UT Chandigarh and submits that petitioner No.2 never informed about her marriage with petitioner No.1 to her parents and even now she off and on goes to the house her parents to live there. Counsel appearing on behalf of UT Chandigarh further submits that in case, any such representation given by the petitioners is pending, the same will be considered and decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law in a given time frame.

5. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to consider representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
