Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has
recorded a statement on 06.09.2024 to the effect that there was no danger to his
life and liberty and did not require protection. With regard to the allegations
that he has been dispossessed by the private respondents from the property
which was lying mortgaged with him, he has further submitted that a civil suit
already been filed by him in this regard. After recording the DDR,
representation filed by the petitioner has been consigned to record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no civil
litigation is initiated by the petitioner. However, at this stage, he seeks
withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy in
accordance with law.
