1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 20.10.2023 passed in CRR (F)-384-2023.
2. Vide previous order dated 16.05.2024, comments from concerned Additional District & Sessions Judge, were called as to why he had not complied the order dated 20.10.2023 passed by this Court. The comments have already been received from the concerned Judicial Officer, wherein it has been stated that the said order was never produced before the Court upto the date when that Court had passed the order. The entire allegations of the petitioner appear to be an after thought.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to show anything to show that the order passed by the High Court, was produced before the concerned trial Court, in time.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
