The Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for the quashing of impugned order dated 13.02.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Trial court for cancellation of bail bonds submitted by the petitioner and issuance of Nonailable warrants in case FIR No.11 dated 24.01.2019 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at P.S. City 2 Mansa, District Mansa.

On 15.05.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ *The Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for the quashing of impugned order dated 13.02.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Trial court for cancellation of bail bonds submitted by the petitioner and issuance of Nonailable warrants in case FIR No.11 dated 24.01.2019 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at P.S. City 2 Mansa, District Mansa.*

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of



noting down of wrong date he was unable to appear on 13.02.2024 on which date the impugned order came to be passed. He states that petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

*Notice of motion for **01.08.2024**.*

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Day Care Centre for Elderly Disabled in home for Old and Destitute People, Sector 15, Chandigarh he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The petitioner is further directed to place on record the photocopy of receipt of payment as well as the order passed by the court below granting interim bail to the petitioner.”

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that in deference to the aforementioned order the petitioner has surrendered and has since been granted the concession of interim bail. He has also deposited the costs as imposed by this Court vide order dated 15.05.2024.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself without any sufficient cause.
