Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners No.1 and 2 were working as Helper and petitioner No.3 was working as Ward Attendant with the respondents but while giving them extension in service vide impugned order dated 05.04.2024 (Annexure P/9), status of the petitioners have been changed to that of Sweeper, which act of the respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are entitled to work on the post on which they were working prior to their extension in service vide impugned order dated 05.04.2024 (Annexure P/9) i.e. helper or Ward Attendant, as the case may be.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the said grievance, a request has already been given to the Deputy Commissioner

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Jind by way of representation dated 19.04.2024 (Annexure P/11), which has already been marked to the Chief Medical Officer, Jind for examination and report but no action is being taken by the respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, representation dated 19.04.2024 (Annexure P/11) is received from the petitioners, the same will be decided by the authority concerned in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioners, the same will be extended to them otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioners will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
