By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays to quash the order dated 12.02.2024 (Annexure P.1) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar whereby bail of the petitioner was cancelled and bonds were forfeited in case FIR No.284 dated 10.09.2020 registered under Sections 307, 120-B, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (offences under Sections 25(6), 25(7), 25(8), (Act No.54 of 1959) of Arms Act, 1959 added later on) at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, Amritsar.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was on bail and was appearing regularly. However, he could not appear on 12.02.2024 because he had already been arrested on 02.02.2024 in case FIR No.381/2023 registered under Section 379/34 IPC at Police Station B Division, Amritsar and later on, also arrested on 15.02.2024 in another case bearing FIR No.88/2023 registered under Sections 379/411/201 IPC, as is evident from Annexures P.5 and P.6. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Court.



Notice of motion.

Mr. Amandeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

This petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court, on or before 30.05.2024 and apply for bail. On his surrender, the Court will proceed against the petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C and after disposal of those proceedings, shall admit the petitioner to bail. However, it is made clear that till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested in view of the warrants of arrest issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
