By way of present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for his release on regular bail in a case arising out of FIR No.5 dated 04.01.2024, under Section 436, 452 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

2. FIR was lodged on the complaint of Chandrika Kumari, as per which, she was residing with Rohit Kaushal (petitioner) since 2017 being friends; that petitioner used to torture her; that she had started ignoring him; that petitioner had expressed his desire to solemnize marriage with her, but she had refused; and that on 04.01.2024, petitioner came to the house of the complainant and put the same on fire by opening the knob of gas cylinder.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that nobody was injured in the present case; that as per investigation, no gas cylinder was found from the spot; that petitioner is in custody for the last more than 04 months with no other case pending against him; and that the trial may take time to conclude.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Ram Kumar Singla, DAG, Harayana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

6. Learned State counsel concedes the fact that nobody was injured in the case.

7. As per the custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last 04 months and 13 days with no criminal antecedent. Trial is likely to take long time.

8. Having regard to all the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
