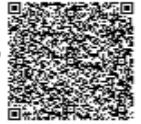

1. Present application has been filed under Rule 3-A(i) of Chapter 6 Part B Volume V of the High Court Rules and Orders for grant of leave to file the present petition without Number of Roll of Advocate.

2. In view of the averments made in the application, same is allowed and leave sought is granted.

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3. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to consider and decide



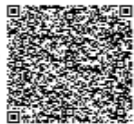
the representation dated 12.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) and to initiate appropriate legal action against respondent No.4.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner is a married woman and is peacefully living with her husband and children. Whenever daughter of the petitioner goes out of the house for school or for any other work, respondent No.4, with bad intention, starts harassing her. It is further contended that when the petitioner complained about this wrong act of respondent No.4 to his mother, she did not pay any heed. On coming to know about the said complaint made to his mother, on 18.04.2023, respondent No.4 along with his 9-10 friends, who were having sharp-edged weapons, forcibly entered house of the petitioner and threatened to kill all of her family members and thus, respondent No.4 made their lives hell. The aforementioned incident can be confirmed from the CCTV footage, which has been preserved by the petitioner. The petitioner, through her counsel, has submitted a representation to respondents No.2 & 3 to take appropriate action against respondent No.4, but till date, no action has been taken.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 12.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

6. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

7. On asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab,



accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of complete paperbook to learned State counsel during course of the day.

8. Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 12.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
