1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the dispute with regard to Mutation No.534 registered as 'Contested Mutation No.534' of village Bagthala, Tehsil Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, as expeditiously as possible in a time bound manner as the core dispute of ownership with regard to the land in question of ownership with regard to the land in question stands settled by the final judgment passed by this Court in RSA-2866-1988 decided vide order dated 12.04.2019 (Annexure P-8).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that proceedings with regard to Mutation No.543 registered as 'Contested Mutation No.534' of village Bagthala, Tehsil Thanesar, District Kurukshetra are pending before respondent No.2 since long, however, the same has not been adjudicated till date. He has further prayed that respondent No.2 be directed to conclude the partition proceedings in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana



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accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from Mr. Sulinderpal, SDM, Kurukshetra has submitted that the case is fixed for final arguments on 03.07.2024 and the same would be decided on the date fixed.

5. Heard.

6. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Sub Divisional Officer (Civil)-cum- Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Thanesar to decide the case pending before him on the date fixed i.e. 03.07.2024, in case there is no legal impediment in the present case. Respondent No.2 is free to take into consideration the stay, if any granted by any higher authority/Court in the present case and proceed further in accordance with law.

7. A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2 forthwith who on receipt of the same will proceed with the matter.
