The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.199 dated 01.11.2023 under Sections 458, 380, 323, 506, 427, 148, 149, 436 IPC registered at P.S. Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.05.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 17.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 17.05.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation



as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
