This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 24.01.2020 passed in CR-7480-2018.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the entire amount as per the order of the Family Court and as clarified by this Court in CR-7480-2018, has already been deposited with the Executing Court. The said aspect also shows that the petitioner is already before the Executing Court.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise grievance before the Executing Court, but in accordance with law.
