In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioner is that keeping in view the order dated 15.03.2022 (Annexure P/5) passed by the respondents, the suspension period of the petitioner from 19.02.2016 to 20.01.2017 has been treated as duty period for all intents and purposes and hence, the respondents are under an obligation to grant the petitioner full salary for the said period, which is not being granted by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P/7) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Mr. Satnampreet Singh, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, legal notice dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P/7) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for non accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
