[1] The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail by way of petition
filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.0082 dated 15.03.2023
under Section 306 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi,
District SAS Nagar.

[2] On 17.05.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

Ms. Izairra Mittal, Advocate for the petitioner.

Mr. Karan Bansal, Advocate for complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the
implication of the petitioner in the FIR in question was an offshoot of civil
dispute arising out of agreements to sell dated 09.08.2022 and 27.09.2022,
besides it, even no instigation for abetment can be attributed to the
petitioner.

Notice of motion for 03.08.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join investigation before
the Investigating Officer as and when called. In the event of his arrest, the
Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of

hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

[3] Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Nathi Ram, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 17.05.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[4] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 17.05.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
