After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the enquiry report dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P/21) has been submitted by the Enquiry Officer, which report has already been forwarded to the petitioner for his comments, the petitioner will take all the objections required against the enquiry report before the authority concerned by filing an appropriate reply/objections to the said enquiry report and said reply/objections may kindly be taken into account by the punishing authority while deciding the case of the petitioner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

Keeping in view the advance copy served, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab appears for the respondent-State and assures this Court

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that in case, any reply is filed by the petitioner against the enquiry report and any objection is raised therein, the same will be taken into account by the punishing authority before forming an opinion and after considering all the facts, appropriate order will be passed by the authority concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for and in case, any order passed by the authority concerned causes prejudice to the petitioner, remedy against the order can be availed by the petitioner.
