

notice during the cross-examination of the respondent-complainant and also to produce the same in his defence evidence.

4. In view of the aforesaid submission, present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court that it will permit the petitioner-accused to cross-examine the complainant-respondent by confronting the reply to the legal notice, which the petitioner-accused wants to produce and will also permit the petitioner-accused to produce that reply in his defence evidence. It is made clear that necessary relevance and the legal value to be attached to that evidence are to be considered at appropriate stage. Disposed of accordingly.

As present order has been passed without issuing any notice to the respondent-complainant, therefore, he will be at liberty to approach this Court, if feels aggrieved by this order.
