SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed under Sections 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing orders dated 11.04.2022 and 07.11.2023, Annexures P-3 and P-5, passed by respondents No. 3 and 2, respectively.
2. Advance copy, although incomplete, has been served upon the respondents.
3. Mr. Aggarwal, State counsel, submits that the petitioner has an alternative remedy of filing a revision petition under Section 115 of the Haryana Co-operative Societies Act, 1984 (for short ‘the Act’).
4. As the petitioner has an alternative statutory remedy, which he has not availed, prayer made in the writ petition cannot be entertained. Petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedy available to him under the Act.
