Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondent-Nigam to remove the respondents No.11 to 13 who, as per the petitioner did not fulfill the requisite qualification and had obtained bogus certificates of the Industrial Training Institute issued by the Global Institute of Information Technology, Karnal.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 6-DHBVNL contends that action has already been taken on the said complaints and that the private respondents have been disengaged. It is also pointed out that the said employees have thereafter preferred CWP-

13401 of 2024 which is now pending in this Court.



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The aforesaid assertion is not disputed or denied by any of the parties. In the said circumstances, I find that in so far as the grievance espoused in the present petition is concerned, the same already stands redressed.

The present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The parties shall be at liberty to pursue their respective merits in the pending writ petition. The petitioner may, if so advised, move an appropriate application in the pending writ petition as well.
