Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 19.04.2024 (Annexure P-14) passed by respondent No.3 – Sub-Registrar-cum-Tehsildar, Tehsil Gharaunda, District Karnal, whereby the power of attorney presented by the petitioner has been refused to be registered on the pretext that the petitioner and the performa respondents are not residents of Gharaunda.

A status report was sought for from the respondent-State, whereupon an affidavit of Jangsher Singh, Inspector-SHO, Police Station Gharaunda has been filed, as per which the petitioner and the performa respondents are residents of Ward No.11, Gharaunda, District Karnal.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the submission of the aforesaid compliance report and the averments contained therein including the Aadhar Cards depicting the residential addresses of the petitioner and the performa respondents being residents of Gharaunda. He further contends that in

the event of the petitioners and performa respondents approaching the respondent No.3 – Sub-Registrar-cum-Tehsildar, Tehsil Gharaunda, District Karnal alongwith all supporting documents showing their place of residence at Gharaunda, necessary steps for execution and registration of the power of attorney shall be undertaken.

In view of the aforesaid statement, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant writ petition any further.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

Needless to mention that in the event of the petitioner and the performa respondents approaching the respondent No.3 – Sub-Registrar-cum-Tehsildar, Tehsil Gharaunda, District Karnal for seeking registration of the power of attorney alongwith all supporting documents, the respondent-Authority shall take appropriate steps in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the earlier order passed by this Court.
