HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners, by way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in complaint case bearing COMI/18/2024 (earlier CRM/47/2017), instituted on 31.05.2017, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-Bof IPC, wherein they were summoned for facing trial vide order dated 15.02.2024 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul.

[2] This Court, while issuing notice of motion vide order dated 17.05.2024, directed the petitioners to appear before the trial Court on or before the date fixed i.e. 28.05.2024 and in the event of their appearance, they were ordered to be granted interim bail subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a copy of order dated 22.05.2024 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate,

Phul, which reflects that the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and their bail/surety bonds have been accepted. The aforesaid order dated 22.05.2024 is re-produced hereunder:-

Present: Accused Gursharan Singh and Sukhvir Singh in person represented by Sh. PK Garg, Advocate

File taken up today as accused Gursharan Singh and Sukhvir Singh surrendered before this Court and moved bail application through his counsel. The perusal of file shows that vide order dated 17.05.2024 passed by the Hon’ble High Court accused Gursharan Singh and Sukhvir Singh were granted interim bail in this case, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Order confirmed. Report of Ahlmad seen. In compliance of order of the Hon’ble High Court as referred above, accused are admitted to interim bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount each. Bail/surety bonds have been furnished by accused, which are accepted and attested. Now, file be put up on the date already fixed.
