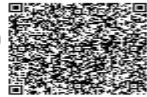

1. Petitioner Vinod Basa @ Vinod Raj has filed instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.11 dated 15.01.2024 under Sections 307, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Division 6, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

2. As per the facts of the case FIR has been registered on the statement of Maninder Singh @ Mani. Occurrence took place on 15.01.2024. Complainant was present at home when he received call of Komi Goel who called him at about 8.30 am on mobile phone that he will help him in effecting compromise with Harsh Mahajan @ Romi. At



about 11.30 am he reached near Atma School, Jain Colony, Ludhiana. Both Komi Goel and Harsh Mahajan were present there. Brother-in-law of Harsh Mahajan namely Vinod Raj also reached there. After some time, 8-10 persons also came in different cars armed with deadly weapon. On seeing them, he, his brother and friend tried to escape from there. They started beatings them with their respective weapons and gun shots were also fired with the intention to kill them. With these allegations present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 16.05.2024. In pursuance of this, he has already joined the investigation. It is further alleged that matter has been compromised with the complainant party.

4. Status report has been filed which is taken on record. It is confirmed that petitioner has already joined the investigation.

5. Mr.Ranveer Singh Sekhon, Advocate has filed his vakalatnama on behalf of complainant Maninder Singh and others. He also confirmed that matter has been compromised between the parties and they have no objection in case petitioner is granted anticipatory bail.

6. I have considered the aforesaid factual position. Petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 16.05.2024 and in pursuance of this he has joined the investigation. As per version of complainant, matter has been compromised. Petitioner is still ready to abide by the terms of bail order and join investigation as and when required.

7. Considering the aforesaid factual position that petitioner has already joined investigation and matter has been settled between the parties,



therefore, interim bail, already granted vide order dated 16.05.2024 stands confirmed subject to same terms and conditions.

- 8. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
- 9. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
