1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

2. Learned counsel submits that the daughter of petitioners No.1 and 2 performed love-marriage with one Gaurav, which was initially not accepted by the petitioners No.1 and 2, however subsequently, they along with their family members have now accepted the marriage of their daughter with Gaurav, but the private respondents who too are their relatives are still not ready to accept the said relationship, as a result of which they are extending threats of dire consequences to the petitioners.



3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that they would restrict their prayer and will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide their representation dated 03.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously.

4. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

5. At the asking of Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into the representation dated 03.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
