The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.32 dated 22.02.2024, registered under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D, 120-B, 148 & 149 of IPC and Sections 25(1), E(2), 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.
