1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for directing the respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to take action on the complaint dated 29.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) and complaint No. 317 Peshi dated 03.05.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. In compliance of order dated 22.05.2024, the parties have resolved their entire dispute and has handed over a demand draft of Rs.2,75,000/- to the counsel for respondent Nos. 6 and 7.

3. Both the parties are bound down to their obligations as agreed in the compromise and the passport be released to the petitioner against proper receipt by the Reader of this Court today itself.

4. Accordingly, this petition is disposed of.

5. The complaints lodged by the petitioner and respondent Nos. 6 and 7 against each other shall also be consigned to record room with no



further action against them subject to payment of cost of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited by the petitioner and Rs.5,000/- to be deposited by respondent Nos.6 and 7, within one month from today in **Nishkam Sewa Group (run by Punjab & Haryana High Court Lawyers at Chandigarh).**
