Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for amendment of the head note and prayer clause of the main petition whereby earlier prayer has been made for quashing of order dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) instead of quashing of order dated 01.04.2024 (Annexure P-6) in case FIR No.52 dated 09.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 18 and 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana Rural.

In view of the reasons mentioned the application, duly supported by an affidavit, same is allowed. Accordingly, prayer for quashing of the order dated 01.04.2024 is ordered to be written in the headnote as well as in the prayer clause of the petition.

Registry is directed to do the needful.

Main petition

Notice of motion.

Ms. Manjot Kaur, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State counsel submits that vide order dated 11.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by Ld. Judge, Special Court-I, Ludhiana the petitioner was ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.90,000/- with one surety in the like amount. On 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) the petitioner failed to appear before the Court and his bail bonds and surety bonds were ordered to be cancelled and forfeited to the State and non-bailable warrant were issued.

Since bail of the petitioner was not cancelled so petitioner is entitled for grant of concession of bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bonds as and when he appears in the Court. Accordingly, petitioner is directed to surrender before the concerned Court within a period of one week from today. In case of doing so, he shall be released on bail on furnishing of fresh bail bonds and surety bonds as per terms of the order dated 11.08.2020 (Annexure P-2).

The concerned Court shall give notice to the petitioner under Section 446 Cr.PC and after getting reply, shall pass an appropriate order regarding previous bail bonds/surety bonds.

Petition stands disposed of.
