1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to register FIR while taking into consideration application dated 26.12.2023 moved to respondent No.4, which was forwarded to respondent No.2 with complaint No. CMS/2024/009654 dated 10.04.2024, whereby, petitioner has been served 03 continuous notices, but no action has been taken.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the official respondents to decide application/representation dated 26.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Manish Kumar Bansal, Public

Prosecutor with Mr. Shubham Mangla, Advocate for respondent-U.T.,

Chandigarh appear on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner. Requisite copies of the petition have already been supplied to the respondents-State by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Jind, Tehsil and District Jind, Haryana, to look into the representation dated 26.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 02 (two) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
