Short affidavit dated 08.11.2024 of Sh. Gursimran Singh Dhillon, Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Land Acquisition Collector, Amritsar, filed on behalf of respondent No. 2, is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite side.

[3] As per the aforesaid affidavit dated 08.11.2024, the amount of compensation stands deposited by respondent No. 1-NHAI, which shall be credited into the accounts of petitioner within a period of one week from today.

[5] However, in case any cause survives as regards the interest, the petitioner would be at liberty to submit a representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today; upon receipt thereof, the respondent(s) concerned, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, shall pass a speaking order within four weeks thereafter, while forwarding the copy of same to him within a period of one week thereafter.

[6] It is made clear that respondent-State of Punjab shall be bound by the stand as taken in the aforesaid affidavit dated 08.11.2024.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
