1. The petitioners through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to consider their representation dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. The petitioners claim that they are part-time Class-IV employees and working with respondent for the last more than three decades. They, as per policy of the State, are eligible to be regularized.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance of the petitioners at this stage, would be redressed, if respondents are directed to consider their representation in the light of prevailing regularization policy.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service and submits that Competent Authority would consider representation of the petitioners in accordance with prevailing

6. Without commenting upon merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider claim of the petitioners, in accordance with prevailing policy.
