By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.172 dated 07.11.2023 registered under Sections 294/341/324/323/148/149 IPC (later on added offence under Section 326 IPC and later on deleted/ reduced offence under Section 294 IPC) at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only role attributed to the petitioner is that he had given sword blow on the right hand of the complainant- injured Kulwant Lal, which resulted in cutting down of his fingers.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Custody certificate has been placed on record.

5. Learned State Counsel contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner attracts Section 326 IPC.



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6. As per the custody certificate placed on record, petitioner is in custody for the last 01 month and 27 days. Trial may take time to conclude. Petitioner does not have any other criminal case pending against him.

7. Looking into the nature of injuries attributed to the petitioner and all the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
