1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of order dated 13.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the respondent-Corporation qua the petitioner, whereby it has been ordered to deduct 20% out of the pension of the petitioner and order dated 28.09.2022 (Annexure P-2), whereby the appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 6 produced a copy of letter dated 14.09.2022, wherein it has been stated that the respondents are withdrawing the appellate order and shall pass fresh speaking order, after giving personal hearing to the petitioner. Copy of letter dated 14.09.2022 is taken on record.

3. Since the order dated 28.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Appellate Authority has been withdrawn, therefore, the instant writ

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petition been rendered infructuous.

- 4. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
- 5. The Appellate Authority shall pass a speaking order after granting personal hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 03 months, if not already passed.
