This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner alleging threat to her life and liberty has moved the representation dated 13.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) to the Commissioner of Police, District Sonapat, but till date no action thereon has been taken. Hence, the present petition with limited prayer that the aforesaid representation will be considered and disposed of in an expeditious manner. He further prays that there are typographical error in the synopsis attached with the petition and seeks withdrawal of the same.



3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits the SHO, Police Station Murthal, District Sonipat, has already inquired into the matter and recorded the statements of the private respondents, who have categorically stated that neither they have extended any threat nor will they do so in future. Copy of the statements have been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners as well.
5. After perusing the statements, learned counsel for the petitioner has very fairly sought withdrawal of the instant petition at this stage.
6. Accordingly, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
