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**HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)**

1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 09.09.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-24453-2021.

2. In response, learned counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of letter dated 14.10.2024, issued by the State Bank of India, Branch, HAU Hisar, as per which, family pensionary benefits in favour of the petitioner shall be processed within 3-4 working days and the amount shall be disbursed/credited in her account by the end of this month.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not

want to press the present petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the  
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at  
liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the  
erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs  
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation  
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
