This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.PC for directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioners, apprehending threats to their lives and liberty and feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No.4 to 7, had moved the representation dated 16.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent of Police Karnal, District Karnal, (Haryana), but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police



Karnal, District Karnal, Haryana, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 16.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
- 5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police Karnal, Distrit Karnal, Haryana, to consider and dispose of the representation 16.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners.
- 7. Disposed of.
