1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents as well as to act against them in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel inter alia contends that admittedly there is a civil dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents; the petitioner is in possession of the property which is the subject matter of civil litigation between the parties; the private respondents have however, been trespassing into the property of the petitioner repeatedly, extending threats of dire consequences and on a couple of occasions have also tried to demolish the boundary-wall of her house. Learned counsel has submitted that complaints (Annexures P-1 and P-2) in the said regard had been given to the authorities concerned including



respondent No.3-SSP, Patiala, however, no steps had been initiated by the official respondents to come to her rescue and protect her life and liberty.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner would restrict her prayer and will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide her representations dated 30.04.2024 and 10.05.2024 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) expeditiously.

4. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

5. At the asking of Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representations dated 30.04.2024 and 10.05.2024 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
