By way of present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for his release on regular bail in a case arising out of FIR No.132 dated 14.04.2024, under Sections 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the NDPS Act') (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Amabla City.

2. As per the allegations, co-accused, namely, Sunita was apprehended on 14.04.2024 and 19 grams, 500 mg. of smack was recovered from her. It is further the allegation that in the disclosure statement, said Sunita nominated the petitioner as supplier.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated; that she has never indulged in any such activity; that even the recovered quantity of contraband from co-accused Sunita is non-commercial in nature; and that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than 01 month.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.
6. Learned State counsel could not refute any of the aforesaid contentions.
7. As per the custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 01 month and 13 days. She has no other criminal case pending against her.
8. Considering all the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail. She is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
