The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/release the benefits to the petitioner as per Clause 11 of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016.

At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case second respondent is directed to decide his pending representation, dated 06.04.2024 Annexure P-5, in a specified period.
