1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.07 dated 10.01.2024, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 379-B, 341, 427 and 34 of IPC (Sections 323, 201 and 427 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.
2. As per contents of the FIR, it has been alleged as under:-

“Statement of Karj Singh s/o Sucha Singh s/o Tehal Singh, r/o Bakarwala, P.S Dharamkot, District Moga aged about 33 year, Mobile No. 9914542276 now resident of LNT Finance SCF 123, GT Road, opposite Harchand Cinema Bathinda, stated that I am resident of above mentioned address and doing a private job at LNT Finance Company Bathinda. Our company gave loan to the unemployed ladies for employment and after the month the collection has been taken from

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the group members, from our company given loan to unemployed ladies of Kot Guru on dated 06.01.2024, me and my company colleague Ajay Kumar s/o Bhadur Singh, r/o Malot who on our motorcycle make Hero Splendor Plus after taking collection of loan installments form the ladies of Kot Guru at about 1:00 PM day time when going towards village Jaisinghwala from village Kot Guru via link road, when we gone ahead one and half kilometer on our motorcycle from village Kot Guru, then behind us three Hindu youngsters, one motorcycle was make Platina color Black without Number plate came, and who immediately encircled us and the one Hindu boy who was on motorcycle immediately gave one iron rod blow which was in his hand, with the intention to kill, and same hit behind my head and the other youngster have another rod blow which was in his hand with the intention to kill and same was hit on the head of Ajay Kumar who was driving a motorcycle, and we both fell down from the motorcycle and when I was lying then the collection amount about Rs. 55,750/- which was in my kit bag snatched by them and in kit bag there is one mobile Phone make Apple having Sim Number. 9464671481, and one mobile phone make Oppo having Sim Number 7009842072, in running condition also snatched and in the kit bag there was two EVVLUTE MACHINE and keys of branch, and my personal documents were also taken, from our side noise was raised "Marta Marta" upon which above all 3 youngsters after snatching our belongings ran upon the motorcycle from the spot, and the people after arranging the vehicle admitted us at CHC Sangat

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where doctor referred us for treatment at CH Bathinda where we were under treatment and when after discharge we were going to home, then you met us, from the inquiry conducted till now we came to know the from us with the intention to kill after giving injuries, snatch money and mobile and other articles are snatched by Sukhwinder Singh alia Gagu s/o Gurmail Singh, Balwatn Singh s/o Gagar Singh, Sandeep Singh alias Kalu s/o Balwinder Singh all resident of Kot Guru, legal action be taken against these persons.xxx”

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no specific attribution to the petitioner. The injuries suffered by the petitioner are simple in nature.
4. Petitioner is behind bars for more than 04 months and 07 days. Challan stands presented.
5. State counsel is not in a position to dispute the aforesaid facts.
6. In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
7. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
