Petitioner seeks temporary release (parole) for four weeks in order to perform last rites of his father, who is stated to have unfortunately passed away on 08.05.2024.

2. It is submitted that petitioner, who was involved in FIR No.209 dated 29.03.2019 registered under Sections 323, 302, 506, 34 IPC & Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal was convicted vide judgement dated 29/30.09.2023 and convicted for RI for life under Section 302 IPC. Criminal Appeal No. CRA-D-97-2024 filed by the petitioner is pending adjudication after admission.

3. It is submitted that petitioner's father passed away on 08.05.2024 at Kailash Hospital, Greater Noida. Petitioner has applied for emergency parole but the matter has not been finally decided. It is submitted that though nothing in writing has been given to the petitioner he was verbally told that request for parole has been rejected.

4. Notice of motion.

5. At the asking of Court, Mr. Deepak Grewal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Keeping in view the nature of order being passed, filing of reply on behalf of respondents is not being called for.

6. The matter was kept in the post lunch session to enable learned counsel for the State to seek instructions. Mr. Deepak Grewal, DAG, Haryana refers to communication of even date sent by Police Station Camp, Palwal to submit that *Tehrvi Ceremony* of father of petitioner is slated for 20.05.2024.

7. Learned counsel for State submits that there is no serious objection if the petitioner is allowed to attend *Tehrvi Ceremony* of his father on 20.05.2024 under police custody.

8. Keeping in view the facts and circumstance above, petitioner is permitted to attend *Tehrvi Ceremony* of his father to be held at Village Barsana, District Mathura in police custody on 20.05.2024 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

9. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
