The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26 dated 16.03.2024 under Sections 22(b) of NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 188 IPC and Section 29 of the NDPS Act (added later on) registered at P.S. Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.05.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit dated 19.07.2024 of Mr. Saravjeet Singh Brar, PPS, DsP, City-2, Bathinda in the Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 20.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.



In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.05.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
