The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 6 and for not harassing the petitioner No.1 and his family members in any false criminal complaint, if lodged by the private respondents, or any of their relatives.

This Court has noted from own examination that the date of birth document attached as Aadhaar Card with the petition and also narrated in the pleadings including the date of birth in the memo of parties, petitioner No.1 is a minor girl and as informed by Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab on instructions from HC Ram Singh that there is a missing complaint No.528 dated 29.04.2024, Police Station City-2, Mansa has already been lodged by the father of the minor girl namely Kuldeep Singh-respondent No.4.

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays
for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
