KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in a criminal case having FIR No. 95 dated 20.03.2024 registered under Sections 326, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.
2. The allegations in nutshell are that at the time of occurrence, petitioner caused injuries to the complainant with the help of sword on 19.03.2024.
3. On the last date of hearing, the co-ordinate bench of this Court granted interim bail to the petitioner with directions to deposit amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in fixed deposit which will be subject to final decision of the criminal case and to join investigation with the police.
4. Today, the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that by virtue of the aforesaid order of interim bail, the

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petitioner has joined investigation and also deposited amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in shape of fixed deposit and copy of the same is produced which is taken on record.

5. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh made statement that petitioner has joined investigation and recovery of weapon used in commission of crime is also effected and that the injuries were caused on non vital parts of the body of complainant and that petitioner is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police. Even the deposit of Rs.1,00,000/- by the petitioner in shape of fixed deposit is not disputed by the State counsel

6. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.05.2024 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions as are provided in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
