On 20.03.2024, the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide FIR No.151 dated 01.07.2018 under Sections 304, 323, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioners were declared innocent during the course of investigation and have been summoned to face Trial as additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion for 17.07.2024.

Ms. Ramta K Chaudhary, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meantime, subject to the petitioner’s appearance before the Trial Court within a period of



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one week from today, he shall be admitted to interim bail to its satisfaction.”

In deference of the aforementioned order, the petitioners have surrendered before the Trial Court and have since been admitted to interim bail vide order dated 24.05.2024 passed by the Judge, Special Court. A copy thereof is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.
